Welcome to EUC Syd



Meals and accommodation

International students and guests are accommodated alongside Danish students in EUC Syd boarding facilities or with hosting partners. Fees include full board, bed linen, towels, and Wi-Fi.

Quality assessment

All our programs adhere to the Danish national VET curriculum and are overseen by the Danish Ministry of Education. We implement the European Credit System for Vocational Education and Training (ECVET) and carry out regular evaluations with students and partners to ensure the highest quality in our teaching.

Credits and certification

Our programmes are aligned with EQF Level 3 (beginners), Level 4 (experienced) and Level 5 (advanced). Students can receive a certificate of attendance upon completion.

International partnerships

We prioritise international collaboration and maintain active partnerships with educational institutions across Europe, and overseas countries. Our exchanges are supported by the Erasmus+ programme and other educational initiatives.
